

Zoom out; focus on your big picture

We believe that by minimizing those distractions and zooming-out to focus on your big picture, more sustainable and fulfilling personal financial plans can be placed into action.

So let's zoom-out to examine the hierarchy of personal financial planning. Start here:

STOCK-PICKING AND MARKET TIMING

The financial media and many financial professionals place a lot of focus on purchasing the "right" individual stocks and short-term market timing, which have proven to be the least fruitful use of investor time. While the ubiquitous examples like, "if you invested your pocket change in Amazon in 2000, you would be a bazillionaire today" are alluring, outside of Jeff Bezos himself, who do you know who has done that? The truth is that stock picking and market timing are really difficult, even for the "pros," who have an exceedingly tricky time beating approaches that take very little time and energy to execute. Let's zoom-out a bit...

LOW-COST DIVERSIFICATION > STOCK-PICKING AND MARKET TIMING

Low-cost investment vehicles, many of which replicate market returns with minimal cost, provide a nearly unbeatable advantage over time versus stock picking and market timing. This approach has proven itself time and time again. We believe investment fund selection should focus on placing time and probability on your side by efficiently investing in the market itself. Let's zoom-out another level...

ASSET ALLOCATION > LOW-COST DIVERSIFICATION

Asset allocation, your mix of different investment types like stocks, bonds, real estate, commodities and cash, is much more important than individual security or fund selection. We believe asset allocation determines almost all of the movement, total return, potential for gain, and potential for loss of a portfolio – much more so than individual security or fund selection. Zooming-out!

INVESTOR BEHAVIOR > ASSET ALLOCATION

In our opinion, a well-constructed asset allocation, in the form of a low-

cost diversified portfolio, is only as potent as an investor's ability to deal with the highs and lows of the market cycle. Studies have repeatedly shown that fear and greed can cause investors to make decisions that lead to far inferior investment outcomes than if they did nothing at all. We believe that finding your investment "comfort zone" may allow you to remain steady in the face of volatile markets and is paramount to the long-term success of an investment portfolio. And we're zooming...

ABILITY TO SAVE > ABILITY TO INVEST

Even if you're well-behaved, you actually need to be able to save money to invest! To be clear, investing is very important, and if done incorrectly can be very damaging. But it's much less critical if you don't have a way to contribute money to your portfolio consistently. This is particularly true for younger investors. Investment returns on top of great saving and spending habits can be a very potent financial combination. Zoom, zoom, zoom...

PERSONAL FINANCIAL PLANNING > SAVINGS AND INVESTMENT PLAN

Your ability to save and invest is best served by knowing precisely what you're saving and investing for. While you'll likely do these things no matter what,

you'll be more effective if you have taken the time to construct a thoughtful financial plan with clear objectives. We're almost there!

THE PERSONAL > THE FINANCIAL

Personal financial planning needs to be personal to be successful! Money is a "means" to an end, not an "end" unto itself. So what makes you and your family tick? What types of recreational activities and interests do you appreciate most? What longer-term aspirations do you have? And how does your "day job" support for all of this? Answer these questions, and you're on your way.

By zooming-out, and focusing on what is most important, hopefully you can better visualize your big picture and place your plans into action.
